Thank you to everyone who attended our Annual General meeting. We thanked retiring members of the Board, Amanda Atwell, Karen Long, Valerie Bowker and Phil Hardin, for their service and efforts. New Board members elected are Esther Oaks, Chris Buchanan and Ron Chalmers. They join remaining members Kathy Turnbull, Angela Brigley, LeeAnn Lagace and Allan Terplawy. The financial report showed an annual loss of about \$75,000 after accounting for \$40,000 in annual Casino funds. Our live attendance is still about 60% of pre-COVID numbers.

Many ideas were shared at the meeting. The new Board and I will be following up on these suggestions. One idea from the AGM was a possible increase in fees. A suggestion was made that many members would be willing to pay \$10 instead of \$8 for an entry.
